During high season there is a minimum stay of 2 nights and 3 nights over Bank Holiday weekends

Further booking information:

- 1. A non-refundable and non-transferable deposit of £40.00 per pitch per week is required to make a booking.
- 2. The remaining balance is due one week prior to arrival. If your arrival date is less than a week before, full payment is required at the time of booking.
- 3. Prices include hot water and hot showers (no slot meters).
- 4. Backpacker's rate is £6.40 per person per night, only applicable to DoE, schools and hikers.
- 5. Please arrive for your pitch after 1.00pm and vacate your pitch by 12 midday, unless otherwise agreed.
- 6. Dogs must be kept under control on leads and supervised at all times and are not allowed inside the park buildings.
- 7. For ACSI off season discount cardholders, the euro fee entitles 2 people to a standard grass pitch for a caravan, car and awning with up to 4KWhours per day of electricity, payable in sterling at the current exchange rate.

HOW TO FIND US:

- 1. Head for junction 47 of the M4.
- 2. At junction 47 (Swansea West) take the A483 (2nd left) for Swansea.
- 3. At the next roundabout take the A484 for Llanelli & Gower.
- 4. Straight on for Llanelli & Gower at the next round about.
- 5. At the next roundabout go left on the B4296 for Gowerton & Gower
- 6. Turn Right at the traffic lights on the B4295 for Llanrhidian and Gower.
- 7. Continue to Llanrhidian village (approx. 5 miles).
- 8. At Llanrhidian turn left on B4271.
- 9. After 1 mile take the first right for Reynoldston.
- 10. Over the hill and first left (hard turning) as you approach Reynoldston, signposted to Port-Eynon.
- 11. At the end of the road, turn right onto the A4118 (4 miles to go).
- 12. Pass through Knelston and Scurlage.
- 13. 1 mile after Scurlage, turn left for Horton at Moor Corner Farm.
- 14. The Entrance to Bank Farm is on the right after 100 metres. Follow the tarmacadam road to reception, this avoids narrow lanes and Horton Village.

WARNING:

Directions Sat Nav will try and direct you off the A4118 through Penrice. This is totally unsuitable for caravans!!
